Failure to consent will not allow the use of the images and/or audiovisual footage of the interested party for the purposes indicated above.

### TYPE OF DATA PROCESSED AND PROCESSING METHODS

Interested parties are informed that the processing involves the acquisition of signature, audio, photo and video recordings including their image and/or voice, as well as other data from which their identity can be deduced. The aforementioned data will be processed both with IT tools and on paper supports and on any other type of suitable support, in accordance with the provisions of EU GDPR 679/2016 and the Legislative Decree n. 101 of 10 August 2018, based on the principles of correctness, lawfulness, transparency and protection of your privacy and your rights.

### **DATA RETENTION TERMS**

### RIGHTS OF INTERESTED PARTIES

EU GDPR 679/2016 attributes the following rights to interested parties:

- a) right of access (art. 15 of EU GDPR 679/2016);
- b) right of rectification (art. 16 of EU GDPR 679/2016);
- c) right to cancellation (art. 17 of EU GDPR 679/2016);
- d) right to limit processing (art. 18 of EU GDPR 679/2016);
- e) right to data portability (art. 20 of EU GDPR 679/2016);
- f) right of opposition (art. 21 of EU GDPR 679/2016).

In relation to the processing of data, the interested party may refer to the above-mentioned contacts to exercise their rights.

### RIGHT TO COMPLAIN

If interested parties consider that the processing of personal data relating to them is carried out in violation of the provisions of EU GDPR 679/2016, they have the right to lodge a complaint with the Data Guarantor Authority, as provided for by art. 77 of EU GDPR 679/2016 itself, or to take action in the appropriate judicial offices pursuant to art. 79 of EU GDPR 679/2016.

The Data Controller does not adopt any automated decision-making process, including profiling pursuant to art. 22, paragraphs 1 and 4 of EU GDPR 679/2016.
